

Morton Trophy 2022 - 23

The Morton Trophy is a competition that is played annually between female curlers throughout Scotland. The country is divided into 4 sections and Edinburgh play in the East section along with Borders, Kinross and Kirkcaldy. The winners of each section go onto to play in the Finals in March. This is a competition that is meant to encourage players of all abilities to improve their game and participate in team events.

Edinburgh had a very successful season qualifying for the Semi-Finals/Finals for the first time in over 30 years. A total of 25 different ladies participated in the section games, each and every one playing a vital part in allowing us to finish top of the East section.

Twelve of the above 25 players were chosen to travel to Lanarkshire Ice Rink (Hamilton) on Tuesday 24th March 2023 to play in Finals day. Edinburgh were drawn against Stirling (winners of West section) in the morning Semi-Finals. The games were very competitive and Edinburgh with 2 wins reached the Finals in the afternoon against a very strong Stranraer team (winners of South section). Two of the games were very close and were only decided by the last stone in the last end. Unfortunately, the result did not go Edinburgh's way and last year's winners retained the trophy. Finishing runners up against some strong opposition was an excellent result and Edinburgh are very grateful to all the players who took part in both the Section games and the Finals. Well done!
